

# CERTIFICATE IV IN GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS (PSP40416)



## Brisbane - Public Workshop Program

The *Certificate IV in Government Investigations* (PSP40416) is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification required by people engaged to work as a government investigator. Occupational fields include employment investigations, regulatory compliance, professional standards and fraud/corruption control.

This program is designed for people who require an accelerated pathway to the prescribed nationally recognised qualification and is suitable for people currently working in a role that includes performing government or workplace investigation.

### AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS STANDARDS 2011

#### 1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- Certificate IV in Government (Investigation), or equivalent, ...This qualification should be obtained before an officer is primarily engaged as an investigator; otherwise the officer should be under the supervision of a qualified investigator.

The program consists of 2 workshops. Delivery dates and fees for the next Brisbane program are:

\*The discounted fee of \$1990 (GST-free) applies for registration by the same person in both workshops at the same location.

Workshops are complemented by project tasks which provide participants the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to apply the knowledge and skills developed at the workshops to work situations. Electronic templates are supplied to facilitate projects. Workshops must be completed within sequence and within an 18-month period and may also be completed as 'stand-alone' courses with completion recognised through a *Certificate of Proficiency* (non-AQF).

\*Approx. 600m walk from Central Station or 10 min. free bus ride on Spring Hill Loop bus from Brisbane CBD (runs every 15 mins 6am-6pm).

Workshops run from 9.15am to 4.15pm and are not catered however lunch and beverages may be purchased from the venue or various food/cafe outlets in the immediate vicinity.
