- **Regulatory inspection and enforcement**
- **Monitoring professional standards**
- **Fraud and corruption control**

1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- Certificate IV in Government (Investigation), or equivalent, ...This qualification should be obtained before an officer is primarily engaged as an investigator; otherwise the officer should be under the supervision of a qualified investigator.

PSP40416 is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification required by people engaged to work as a government investigator.

Who:

This course provides an accelerated pathway for people currently working in a role where their duties include conducting government investigations. Other people may successfully complete the course but may be required to undertake a supplementary post-workshop distance learning program (supplied at no additional cost). Suitability advice is available prior to registration by contacting the course coordinator and this is recommended for intending applicants who do not currently work as a government investigator.

When:

The course involves attending the following 2 workshops:

- **Workshop 1 (2-days): 25-26 June 2018**
- **Workshop 2 (2-days): 16-17 July 2018**

Participants complete additional assessment projects during and following the workshop phase which is facilitated through the supply of electronic templates. Enrolment duration is 12 months however students usually complete much earlier depending on their individual learning needs.
