

CERTIFICATE IV IN GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS (PSP40416)



Sydney - Public Workshops Program

The Certificate IV in Government Investigations (PSP40416) is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification required by people engaged to work as a government investigator. Occupational fields include employment investigations, regulatory compliance, professional standards and fraud/corruption control.

This program is designed for people who require an accelerated pathway to the prescribed nationally recognised qualification and is suitable for people currently working in a role that includes performing government or workplace investigation.

AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS STANDARDS 2011

1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- Certificate IV in Government (Investigation), or equivalent, ...This qualification should be obtained before an officer is primarily engaged as an investigator; otherwise the officer should be under the supervision of a qualified investigator.

The program consists of 3 workshops. Delivery dates and fees for the next Sydney program are:

▪ Workshop 1 - Corporate Investigations (2-days)	27-28 August 2018	\$990
▪ Workshop 2 - Recording Interviews (1-day)	29 August 2018	\$590
▪ Workshop 3 - C4 Assessment workshop (1-day)	24 September 2018	\$590

A discounted fee of \$1990 (GST-free) applies when registration by the same person is made in all 3 of the above workshops. Fees are GST-free.

To be awarded the qualification the 3 workshops must be completed within an 18-month period.

The first 2 workshops may be completed as 'stand-alone' courses with completion recognised through a certificate of completion. Public workshops are conducted periodically in Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane.
