

DIPLOMA OF GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS (PSP50416)



Brisbane - Public Workshop Program

The Diploma of Government Investigations (PSP50416) is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification for government investigation supervisors.

SUITABILITY: This program provides an accelerated completion pathway and is only suitable for people who:

- currently supervise government investigations, or
- have completed the Certificate IV in Government Investigations – PSP40416 (or PSP41512), or
- are sponsored by their current government employer to complete this course

1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- **Diploma of Government (Investigation)** for staff primarily engaged in the coordination and supervision of investigations.

*The discounted fee of \$2690 (GST-free) applies for registration by the same person in both workshops at the same location.

Note: People who have completed the *Certificate IV in Government Investigations* with the Sydney Institute of Professional Studies receive credit for workshop 1 and a fee discount for the remaining workshops. The full fee for these students is \$1590

Workshops are complemented by project tasks which provide participants the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to apply the knowledge and skills developed at the workshops to work situations. Electronic templates are supplied to facilitate projects. Workshops must be completed within sequence and within an 18-month period and may also be completed as 'stand-alone' courses with completion recognised through a *Certificate of Proficiency* (non-AQF).

*Approx. 600m walk from Central Station or 10 min. free bus ride on Spring Hill Loop bus from Brisbane CBD (runs every 15 mins 6am-6pm).

Workshops run from 9.15am to 4.15pm and are not catered however lunch and beverages may be purchased from the venue or various food/cafe outlets in the immediate vicinity.
