#### 1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- **Diploma of Government (Investigation)** for staff primarily engaged in the coordination and supervision of investigations.

PSP50416 is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification for people who supervise or coordinate government investigations.

**Who:** This is an accelerated program and registration in this program is open to people who have previously completed the Certificate IV in Government Investigations or who currently supervise or manage government investigations or investigators. People not meeting these requirements, who believe they could successfully complete the course, should contact the course coordinator.

**When:** The course involves attending the following 2 workshops:

- **Workshop 1 (2-days): 27-28 June 2018**
- **Workshop 2 (2-days): 18-19 July 2018**

Participants are also required to complete additional assessment projects after each workshop which are facilitated through the supply of electronic templates.

Light refreshments are provided. Lunch is not provided but there are numerous food outlets in the immediate vicinity of the venue. Workshops commence at 9.30am and conclude at 4.30pm.
