

DIPLOMA OF GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS (PSP50416)



Melbourne - Public Workshop Program

The Diploma of Government Investigations (PSP50416) is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification for government investigation supervisors.

SUITABILITY: This program provides an accelerated completion pathway and is only suitable for people who:

- currently supervise government investigations, or
- have completed the Certificate IV in Government Investigations – PSP40416 (or PSP41512), or
- are nominated and sponsored by their current government employer to complete this course

The program consists of 2 workshops. Delivery dates and fees for the next Melbourne program are:

*The discounted fee of \$2490 (GST-free) applies for registration by the same person in both workshops at the same location.

UPGRADE PROGRAM: People who have completed the *Certificate IV in Government Investigations* with the Sydney Institute of Professional Studies receive credit for workshop 1 and a fee discount for workshop 2. The full fee for these students is \$1590. Access to the Upgrade program is not available for people who have completed the Certificate IV with another RTO.

Workshops are complemented by project tasks which provide participants the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to apply the knowledge and skills developed at the workshops to work situations. Electronic templates are supplied to facilitate projects.

Workshops must be completed within sequence and within an 18-month period and may also be completed as 'stand-alone' courses with completion recognised through a *Certificate of Proficiency* (non-AQF).
