

DIPLOMA OF GOVERNMENT INVESTIGATIONS (PSP50416)



UPGRADE PROGRAM *Online Flexible Completion* (entry requirements apply)

The **Diploma of Government Investigations (PSP50416)** is prescribed by the Australian Government Investigations Standards (AGIS) as the minimum qualification for government investigation supervisors.

This is an upgrade program and uses previously completed coursework to provide eligible applicants with substantial academic and fee credit. Enrolment in this program is restricted to people who have previously completed the *Certificate IV in Government Investigations (C4GI)* with SIPS*. People not meeting the eligibility criteria may enrol in the online Certificate IV program or the online full-course version of the Diploma program with details and dates for both courses available on the SIPS website or by emailing info@sips.edu.au

1.5 Investigator qualifications

The minimum level of training or qualification recommended for investigations staff are:

- **Diploma of Government (Investigation)** for staff primarily engaged in the coordination and supervision of investigations.

COURSE STRUCTURE | This course consists of six sessions with training delivered through electronic written notes (PDF) and streamed online video presentations (YouTube). The notes and links to each session are supplied sequentially on completion of the previous session. Each session includes assessment tasks mapped to prescribed requirements specified for this qualification.

ASSESSMENT | Electronic templates (MS Word) are used to facilitate assessment which is supported by ongoing email tutorial support. Optional online 'live' assessment tutorials are also conducted periodically for participants to receive specific coaching from the course facilitator and discuss assessment with other course participants.

DURATION | Enrolment is for 12 months from commencement which occurs on the supply of notes and links for the first session. Completion is flexible and participants may complete the course in a much shorter time (from 3 months onwards) depending on individual circumstances.

SESSIONS | The six sessions to be completed are:
